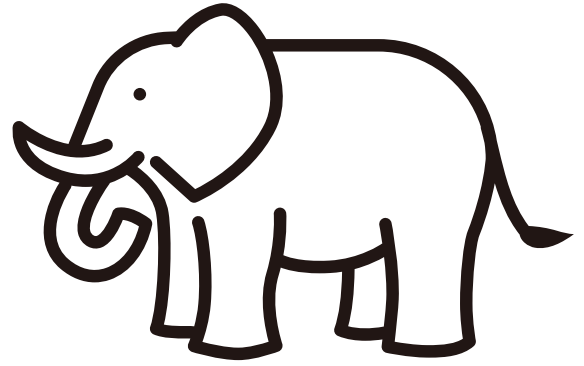


Elephants



Did You Know?

- There are three recognized elephant species: Asian, African savannah and African forest.
- Adult female elephants are called cows; adult males are bulls
- An elephant's trunk can be up to 7 feet long and weigh more than 300 pounds.
- Elephant families are led by the matriarch, who is usually the oldest female.
- The elephant brain weighs more and has more mass than that of any other land animal.
- Elephants' emotions are very similar to human emotions. They feel happiness and sorrow, pride, anger and even jealousy.
